

Developmental Screenings and Evaluations

FDLRS Action does not provide screenings or evaluations. All requests are directed to the appropriate office in the county in which you reside.

Child Find, in coordination with the school districts, assists in the identification of children who may need special services or early intervention. These children, ages ranging from birth through 21– with an emphasis on birth to five, may be eligible for services under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) and links them with needed services.

If you suspect your child needs an evaluation, please contact the appropriate office for the county in which you live.
